MS. PAUL: My name is Cyrille Paul, and you don't have to apologize, because everybody has trouble with that.

I am a resident of South Nyack. I happen to be Vice President of the Board of the Salisbury Point Co-op that sits right next to the Tappan Zee Bridge.

In referring back to some comments that have already been made, I certainly do agree that commuters are important and that it is important for them to have input, but I urge continued consideration of the people who live along the current Thruway, as people have spoken, and also who live directly next to the bridge.

Someone talked about a three level bridge, and my heart hasn't stopped pounding since he said that. I just can't

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2 phantom putting a three level bridge
3 across the River. I once said at one of
4 the previous public hearings that I wanted
5 to know when I looked out my window was I
6 going to look under the bridge or over the
7 bridge, as we currently do. Looking under
8 it would be pretty terrible.

9 The other issue that I'd like to ask
10 about, which I've asked many times and
11 I've never quite gotten the right answer.
12 I've heard that if a new bridge is to be
13 constructed, that it would be built north
14 of the current span, rather than south of
15 it. If it were built south of it, there's
16 no land on the south that it would
17 interfere with. If it's built north of
18 the bridge, it will be right under our
19 windows. And though the object is not to
20 take private land, it wouldn't be too
21 wonderful if you left us sitting there
22 with a bridge 100 feet away from our
23 windows. So that's a concern that we
24 have. We only have 120 apartments in our
25 complex, and we can't quite claim to be as

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2 large as Mountainview Condominiums, but
3 there are a good number of people living
4 there and it's a lovely place to live at
5 this point.

6 Let's see. I just want to -- I
7 guess that's basically what I wanted to
8 discuss. And it really is important,
9 again, that you consider the people who
10 live here, or maybe we could all just move
11 away and the whole area around the bridge
12 and in South Nyack and Nyack can just
13 become a passage way for everybody who
14 wants to commute from Orange County, and
15 then maybe we'll all move up to Orange
16 County and even more people can commute
17 across the bridge.
