20 know, further devastating.

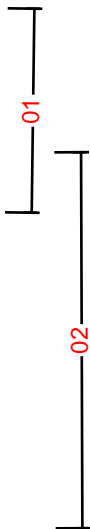
21 So I just -- I've lived in this town
