Overview

The Tappan Zee Bridge carries the New York State Thruway across the Hudson River, between Westchester County and Rockland County. Because of its aged condition, the bridge must be completely replaced with a modern structure that serves today's transportation needs. Here is my proposed plan to provide for the future of that thoroughfare.

Details

The new structure I propose shall have three major parts to it; one bridge support structure each for Route 87 North, Route 87 South, and one more for mass transit, which I believe should be light-rail type train.

So, to summarize, the new bridge system shall be this;
2 separate new bridges, designed and built for motor vehicles. One bridge, currently in use, should be re-built, for use by the mass transit component of this project

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
