Details

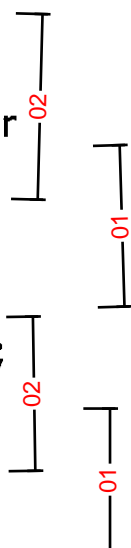
