In the alternatives for the Tappan Zee Bridge/I-287 project, I note that under alternatives 3 and 4, there are options 1 and 2. Option 1 runs on the south side of I-287 along Orange Avenue and Wayne Avenue in Suffern New York. In that option, I will point out, that there are residents and businesses that would have to be bulldozed, and residents would have to be displaced. Yet under option 2, no residents would have to be displaced and have to adjust to new surroundings, as well as being in distress with the shortage of housing in Suffern, and Rockland County. I hope that careful consideration is taken when evaluating the rights of those residents and businesses as well as the historic value of those buildings, which exist in making the decisions of options 1 and 2. I think that it is important that you make an informed decision of knowing how many residents of Suffern New York will be displaced in comparing option 1 versus option 2. I will also point out under option 2, the Piermont line, is an existing active railroad line, which has been in operation for many years.
