I am wondering if your map is correct in the Port Chester area (http://www.tzbsite.com/alternatives/map-pages/alt4a_westchester-east.html). It was my impression that the border between Westchester County (NY) and Fairfield County (CT) turns southward along the Byram River at the eastern margin of Port Chester and Byram (Greenwich), CT. As the map is drawn, the Welcome to Connecticut sign on northbound I-95 is still in New York State.
